1. **Welcome and Apologies for Absence** – There were two apologies of absence received, Cllr A Athwall, Cllr S Fairbrother.
  2. **Declaration of Interests** – Two declarations of interest noted, non-pecuniary, Cllr A Fairbrother Item 12.1 (Signed list in the minute folder).
  3. **Minutes of the Last Meeting** - held on Monday 15 October 2018 – These Minutes were received, considered and approved by the Committee, following the vote. (Signed copy in the minute folder).
  4. **Officer Report/Update/Matters Arising** – None
  5. **Members of the Public** – There were no members of the public present.
  6. **Youth Club** – Tuesday Youth Club/Thursday Youth club – M Clark had produced a written report, copy in C&R minute book. It was agreed that as a matter of urgency a Thursday night progress report be request from Orwell, the organisation running the club, as part of the SLA. There were no reportable incidents. AC confirmed that a review structure on the Youth Clubs would start in the new year.

It was requested that the Market report be obtained from the Market Manager as a matter of urgency as the information would be required for the budget meeting in January. GL requested that new signs for the market be arranged.

14. **Mobile Skate Park** – Discussion taking place with the school and skateboard coach on future on ramps and equipment.
15. **Senior Citizens Outing** – The 2019 outing would take place on Tuesday 20 August.
16. **Christmas Light Switch On event** – Date confirmed for Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2019. It was requested that the rotary club be contacted to see if they would be able to attend this year's event with Santa and the sleigh.
17. **Ice Skating 2018 event** – This year's event was well attended despite the weather, a total of £821 was taken by the Town Council from bookings. The event for 2019 will take place on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November and Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December.
18. **Evening of Reflection** – The tree which was planted previously by the scouts will be used this year, it is situated in the All Saints Churchyard. Next years event is on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December.
19. **The Battles Over** – A well supported community event.
20. **KTC Community and Receptions Awards** – It was agreed that this would be included on the Kesgrave Town Council website in the new year.
21. **Ceremonial Robes, Chairman's Reception/Civil Ceremony** – It was confirmed that ceremonial robes would not be purchased. The Chairman's reception would be looked at after the May elections.
