- Welcome and Apologies for Absence** – The Chair welcomed those present and confirmed apologies received from Councillors C Marsh and N Beecroft-Smith.
- Declaration of Interests** – There were no declarations of interest.
- Minutes of the Last Meeting held on the 1 April 2019** – These Minutes were received, considered and approved by the Committee, following the vote. (Signed copy in the minute book).
- Clerks Report/Update/Matters Arising** – Nothing to report.

- Copy Letters of Objection/In Support/Observations** – None.
- Schedule of Applications/Proposals** – The Committee considered and made its formal comments/recommendations to the Local Planning Authority (LPA). (Copy in minute book).
