- Kesgrave Neighbourhood Plan (NP) Steering Group** – Cllr R Gibson advised that the Decision Statement has been received from East Suffolk Council and that the final version is now ready for referendum. The NP now carries significant weight, the Town Council website has been updated and an article has gone in the In-Touch Magazine. Cllr Beecroft-Smith thanked Cllr Gibson for his hard work.
